

GRAND PRIX PRESS CARTOON EUROPE 2016

The Grand Prix Press Cartoon Europe 2016 was won by **KAP (Jaume Capdevila)** with a cartoon published in **La Vanguardia** on **3 November 2015**. The winner receives a cheque of 5.000 euro and a bronze trophy, designed by Belgian graphical artist Ever Meulen.

A second prize of 2.000 euro, goes to **Tom Janssen** for a cartoon published in **dagblad Trouw** on **8 October 2015** and a third prize, good for 1.000 euro, goes as well to **KAP (Jaume Capdevila)** for a cartoon published in **La Vanguardia** on **11 January 2015**.

The jury was composed by journalist from different countries:

Ronald van Gessel from The Netherlands, Tom Weingärtner from Germany and Jeremy Fleming-Jones Simon and Frédéric from the UK assisted by Vincent Baudoux from the PCE-committee.

The awards will be handed at an official ceremony at the opening of the 55st International Cartoon Festival in Knokke-Heist, Belgium. All cartoons nominated for the PCE (Press Cartoon Europe) and PCB (Press Cartoon Belgium) will be shown at the exhibition of the Cartoon Festival during summer 2016.
